Dear Third and Fourth Grade City of Chicago Teacher:

The Chicago Symphony Orchestra is seeking *outstanding* current third and fourth grade City of Chicago students to participate in an exciting full scholarship program. This program, which began in the fall of 1995, includes weekly classes and private lessons with a member of the Chicago Symphony **free of charge**. The success of this program, which is sponsored by the Negaunee Music Institute at the Chicago Symphony Orchestra, depends on the strength of the recruiting process. We need your help in finding the most talented, hardest-working students in Chicago. Most importantly, we need students who work well with others and have a great sense of responsibility and commitment. Equally important, for students to succeed in the program they must have extremely supportive, dependable parents and a strong sense of self-discipline.

An application is enclosed for distribution to your best students. You can also download an electronic copy from <http://cso.org/PSP>.

If you have more than one student whom you feel is well qualified, you may photocopy the enclosed application. **The student will need to do the following three steps to be considered for this program:**

1. Have the student fill out Part I (student questionnaire).
2. Have you, their teacher; fill out part III (teacher questionnaire).
3. Have the student's parent or guardian do the following:
 - Read the letter addressed to **Dear Parent or Guardian**.
 - Fill out part II of the application (parent questionnaire)
 - Provide **three (3) self-addressed business-size envelopes** with the *student's* home address.
 - Staple all 3 parts of the application (teacher, student, & parent) together and mail (**no FAXs**) the completed forms and envelopes to:

Applications must be postmarked no later than **Friday, May 3, 2019**. **Faxes cannot be accepted**. After this deadline, qualified students & parents or guardians will be invited to attend the Percussion Scholarship Group's spring concert at **7:00pm on Sunday, May 26, 2019** at Symphony Center and schedule an interview. 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Dear City of Chicago Parent or Guardian:

Based on your child's outstanding academic achievement, demonstrated responsibility and ability to work well with others, s/he has been selected to apply for the Chicago Symphony Orchestra's Percussion Scholarship Program. Please take a few moments to review the following information about this opportunity.

This summer, the Chicago Symphony Orchestra will be adding new students to the Percussion Scholarship Program. The selection of your child to be a participant in this program will be based in large part on your willingness to provide him or her with daily encouragement and support of this endeavor. It will require a *firm* commitment from both of you. Scholarship winners will be selected to join the program on a provisional basis after completing a three-stage process:

- **Stage One:** Completion of a well thought-out, neat application in which you have followed all directions carefully.
- **Stage Two:** Applicants who are chosen from stage one are required to attend the Percussion Scholarship Group's free spring concert at Symphony Center at **7:00pm on Sunday, May 26, 2019**. All applicants and their parents or guardians are required to attend this event (no tickets required.) After the concert, a sign-up for private interviews will occur. This will be your *only* opportunity to sign-up for an interview. Interview times cannot be given over the telephone.

Interviews will be Saturday June 1 and Sunday June 2 at Symphony Center in Rehearsal Room F.

- **Stage Three:** A private interview of 10 minutes which will include an opportunity to play the drum for the first time, some simple coordination games, and a few moments for us to get to know you.

Your Child will need to do the following three steps to be considered for this program:

1. Fill out Part I (student questionnaire).
2. Have their teacher fill out part III (Teacher Questionnaire).
3. Have you, their parent or guardian, do the following:
 - Read this letter, addressed to **Dear Parent or Guardian**, carefully.
 - Fill out part II of the application (parent questionnaire)
 - Provide **three (3) self-addressed business-size envelopes** with your home address.
 - Staple all 3 parts of the application (teacher, student, & parent) together & mail (**no FAXES**) the completed forms and envelopes to:
